 - 2. one of many things that will continue to happen in our world!
- B. What about the past?
 - 1. 2004 tsunami in the Indian Ocean killed 214,000 in 14 countries
 - a. have we forgotten? Where was God? Has he abandoned us?
 - b. many survivors still have guilt trips. Why did I survive?
 - 2. 1900 Galveston, TX. 8 to 12,000 perished in the hurricane without warning
 - 3. 1957 worldwide flu pandemic killed 2 million worldwide and 116,000 in the US? Where was God? Asian flu
 - 4. 2011 Joplin, MS 158 people died in that storm- 5 were in a hospital does not God have any mercy? Can't you stop the wind?
 - 5. 2012 Sandy Hook a gunman slew 20 children (ages 6,7) and 6 adults- remember? Where is God? On his throne in the same place where he was in Matthew 2:16 Herod slew innocent children two years and under.
 - 5. 2020 Cookeville, TN -Kimberlin family died in Cookeville, TN
 - 6. Do you believe in God? Where is he? Still in heaven
- C. What is he teaching us?

I. He has Control over All

- A. He can stop both the wind a a virus what what is his answer?
 - 1. Romans 8:20- the context (Rom. 8:1)
 - a. speaks of creation it was subjected to "vanity" in hope
 - b. a very serious, crippling virus when sin entered the world something happened
 - 2. Our condition: we are subjected to futility and vanity
 - a. everything we try to do in life we fall back -
 - b. God is allowing this!
 - c. this message of futility has brought our nation to its knees
 - d. no NFL this season! what no NBA? No March madness?

- e. economic increase that was best in all of history! Riding high jobless rate down, but something we cannot see stop us in our tracks! Effecting us mentally, etc
- f. "I feel futile" this has happened before again!
- g. THIS IS OUR CONDITION!
- 3. Not willingly: subjected since sin entered the world decay and death
 - a. not just on the ungodly, but even saints are suffering
 - b. no matter what we do to take care of ourselves, the universal human condition is decay and death God helps us see this in remarkable ways
- 4. God's design subjected in hope! (1 Tim. 1:1; Col, 1:3-5)
 - a. "subjected" -i.e placed under something fultility
 - b. God is saying to man: "look to me"!
 - c. Jesus, neither the stock market nor our comfortable lives, is our hope! In heaven
 - d. this life will be futile we will decay and we will die!
 - e. look to God and Jesus for hope!
- 5. Our focus: waiting in hope for the redemption of our body (Rom. 8:21-23)
 - a. from corruption to liberty! (Vs. 21)
 - b. waiting for the redemption of our body (vs. 23) our hope!
 - c. no matter how rich or scientific, or power you will die!
- 6. thus, the lesson vs. 20 all in this together!

B. What did Jesus say?

- 1. Lk. 13:1-5 will you all perish?
 - a. people massacred by Pilate or a tower fell
 - b. people died! How did God handle this?
 - c. it was not because they were more sinners than the rest that they died!
 - d. but, message was repentance- concerned about the spiritual condition of men all in his together
 - e. will you look to the only one who can give you hope?
- 2. Roman 8:35: nothing can separate us from God's love
 - a. "tribulation" look at the list! "Persecution" but much of this simply the condition of humanity!
 - b. "anguish", "distress"- cannot separates us
 - c. neither can "peril" (2 Cor. 11:26) when our priority set upon God is heaven cannnot be separated from God's love. When is this is our focus, we can endure!
- 3. God has not abandoned us! Look up in God and Christ- he is there!
 - a. tsunami- of one woman who held two children, but had to let one of them go and embrace the other!

- b. or another who lost her only child because she has no energy!
- c. do the best we can! Remember God still loves us!
