

## **A NOTE RE: ADD'L OPTIONS TO MEET IN PERSON AT THE BUILDING**

As announced this week, beginning next Sunday, March 31, 2020, there will be some additional ways in which you can join the 10:00AM worship assembly at the building. As we continue to transition back to being together in person for our worship services, we want each member to know how much we love and care for you and that regardless of which personal choice you make in these steps, our purpose is to support and encourage you in your service to God and worship in spirit and in truth.

### **4 options will be offered beginning Sunday March 31st:**

- If after evaluating your personal circumstances, you feel it is best to continue to shelter in place, the zoom stream will continue to be available for a time. Instructions will continue to be sent out weekly.
- If after evaluating your personal circumstances you feel comfortable assembling in person inside the building, this portion of the assembly will continue as it has for the past few weeks with the same precautions and instructions previously provided. Please park only in front of the building. See attached instructions regarding the parking arrangement.
- If after evaluating your personal circumstances, you feel it is best for you to meet with us while staying in your car, a few spaces will be available in the rear of the building. Please see attached instructions for where to park and how to ensure you can hear.
- If after evaluating your personal circumstances, you feel it is best for you to meet with us in a socially distanced seating arrangement outside of the building, please wear a mask/ face covering, bring your own lawn or camping chairs and stay within the designated locations. Please see attached instructions for where to park and sit.

**Please respect and adhere to these instructions as they are in place to address specific concerns that make many of our brothers and sisters feel comfortable attending in person.**

### **For those joining the worship from outside the building, please note the following:**

- ***Please let ALAN MEADOWS and JACOB WALKER know if you plan to sit outside so they have a headcount and can plan accordingly.***
- ***Anytime you are out of your car in the space being used behind the building, you will need to wear a mask.***
- If you are staying in your car, once parked please turn your car off if possible for the duration of the service to minimize exhaust and noise disturbances. You may put your windows down at your own discretion.
- If you are not able to bring your own chairs, let Alan or Jacob know so that they can arrange to have a few set out for your use.
- For now, we are not sure how loud the sound system will be outside. If you are in your car and not able to hear, you may call into the zoom number for the lesson and listen

from your phone. However, do not expect to be able to access the building's wifi network from the parking lot. If we need to add more speakers in the future, we will once we better understand the need.

- Please plan to bring your own Lord's Supper elements. If you have questions about preparing them yourself, please ask Debbie Cleveland. If you would like to use the prepared elements being used inside, please let Jacob or Alan know so that we can make proper arrangements to have some set out for you to pick up.
- If desired, slides for the songs and sermon can be provided in a number of formats for you to view on your own device. Please let Jacob know and he will email you a copy.
- Keep in mind that the only restroom facility is inside the building. Since the service is shorter, hopefully you can plan accordingly for yourself and your children, but you may use the restrooms inside at your own discretion.
- Please clean up after yourself and "pack out what you pack in". There will not be anyone circulating outside to pick up containers after the Lord's Supper.
- When it is time to leave, please follow the reverse order indicated on the attached plan. Please be careful to maintain the minimum distancing requirements as you leave. Tents and chairs will be sanitized and put away by a few of the men after everyone has left.
